UPDATE ON UC HEALTH'S PREPAREDNESS FOR EBOLA

Recently, the California Department of Public Health and the Governor's office identified UC's five medical centers as priority hospitals to treat confirmed Ebola cases. (Copies of this announcement were distributed to the Regents from the Office of the President.) The announcement was issued following informal discussions with UC Health's medical center chief executive officers, chief medical officers, and chief nursing officers. Senior Vice President Stobo will update the Regents on UC Health's activities relating to Ebola preparedness.
