UPDATE ON SYSTEMWIDE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REVISED POLICY ON OUTSIDE PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES AND REPORT ON 2015 COMPENSATED OUTSIDE PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES: INCUMBENTS IN SENIOR MANAGEMENT POSITIONS

Update on Systemwide Implementation of Revised Policy on Outside Professional ActivitiesFollowing the Regents' approval of the proposed policy revision in July, the Office of the President began communications, training, and implementation of the new policy. The following actions have been taken:

- A communication will be sent to the State legislature summarizing the changes to the policy on outside professional activities (OPA), meeting the University's obligations under the 2016 Budget Act to provide an update by January 1, 2017.
- The charter and construct of the Independent Review Committee has been created. This Committee will include staff knowledgeable of the OPA policy, such as senior campus leadership, ethics and compliance representatives, campus and OP legal counsel, human resources staff and staff from Audit and Compliance. In addition, the Vice President of Systemwide Human Resources and the Executive Director of Systemwide Compensation Programs and Strategy will provide facilitation and administrative/operational support to the Committee.
- Detailed administrative guidelines, procedures and workflows have been established to define the process to help ensure that SMG members understand the policy and documentation requirements as well as reporting obligations.
- Communications and training sessions are planned to ensure that SMG members understand the new policy requirements. In addition, training and communications are planned for those administrators who are responsible for advising SMG members on policy interpretation and who have responsibility for collection and submittal of documentation requesting approval of activities.

Annual Report on 2015 Compensated Outside Professional Activities

Each year, the University produces and provides to the Regents a report displaying details of the previous year's compensated outside professional activities for all members of the Senior Management Group. This year, consistent with requirements contained in the 2016 Budget Act, the report on 2015 compensated activities is attached.

As stated in the Senior Management Group Outside Professional Activities policy (Regents Policy 7707):

"Considerable benefit accrues to the University from Senior Management Group (SMG) members' association with external educational and research institutions, not-for-profit professional associations, federal, state and local government offices and private sector organizations. Such associations foster a greater understanding of the University of California and its value as a preeminent provider of education, research, public service, and health care. Such associations also may provide a stimulus for economic development and enhanced economic competitiveness.

While outside professional activities performed by SMG members are often mutually beneficial to the University and its members themselves, and are therefore encouraged, the primary commitment of University of California SMG members must be to the fulfillment of their regular University responsibilities."

This report covers compensated service performed in calendar year 2015. The policy in effect during this time had the following limitations and requirements, as described in section III.B.3.a (the policy governing outside professional activities for 2015 did not incorporate the latest revisions that the Regents adopted in July 2016):

- i. An SMG member may serve simultaneously on up to three for-profit boards that are not entities of the University of California for which s/he receives compensation and for which s/he has governance responsibilities.
- ii. An SMG member is required to use his/her personal time to engage in compensated OPA, by either performing such activities outside his/her usual work hours or debiting accrued vacation time consistent with applicable leave policy.
- iii. An SMG member who is appointed at 100 percent time shall not receive additional compensation for any work or services from an entity managed exclusively by the University, regardless of source or type of payment, with the exception of University Extension.

The attached report reflects the individually certified declarations of every member of the SMG regarding their compensated OPA that occurred in calendar year 2015. SMG members who left the University before January 1, 2016 and those who served in SMG positions in an acting capacity are not included in this report. Compensated OPA that occurred before 2015, or before the SMG member's appointment to their SMG position, are not included in the report.

Following the individual certification by SMG members, the chancellors, the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory Director, and the division and department heads of the Office of the
