Item 303, Committee on Educational Policy: Board of Admissions and Relations with Schools (BOARS) Preliminary Recommendations for Changes in Freshman Eligibility Requirements

Ms. Stacey Lee, a student at the Los Angeles campus representing the University of California Student Association, reported that UCSA could not support the changes in eligibility requirements being proposed by BOARS. She discussed the harmful consequences in admissions to UC's selective campuses as the result of the passage of Proposition 209 and urged that the Board consider a more vigorous approach to achieving diversity than that formulated by BOARS.
