

**THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA
MEETING AS A COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE**

July 19, 2016

The Regents of the University of California met on the above date at UCSF–Mission Bay Conference Center, San Francisco.

In attendance: Regent-designate Mancina, Faculty Representatives Chalfant and Hare, Secretary and Chief of Staff Shaw, General Counsel Robinson, Chief Compliance and Audit Officer Vacca, Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer Brostrom, and Recording Secretary Johns

The meeting convened at 2:10 p.m. with Regent Zettel presiding.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Regent Zettel explained that the Board had been convened as a Committee of the Whole in order to permit members of the public an opportunity to address University-related matters. The following person addressed the Board concerning the item noted.

Ms. Christina Hildebrand, member of A Voice for Choice, expressed concern about new immunization requirements for UC students, which she stated were too strict and stricter than laws in any state. Her organization had opposed California Senate Bill 277 the previous year, and it was now asking the University to allow a doctor to have the final say about medical exemptions for students who have been vaccine-injured. UC was mandating the measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine, which can cause arthritis or joint pain in postpubescent women.
