

## Access: California Master Plan

#### **Establishes:**

- Student eligibility
- Admission guarantee
- Priority in admissions
- 60/40 ratio

## Access: Transfer Student Characteristics

- Slightly older than continuing juniors
- Lower socioeconomic backgrounds
- First-generation college-goers
- Ethnically diverse

## Success: Foundation through Articulation

Articulation = evaluation of course comparability

- Establishes links between:
  - CCC courses → UC courses
  - CCC courses → UC major preparation
- Agreements online at www.assist.org

## Success: Progress in Articulation

- More than doubled the number of UC courses articulated since 1999-00
  - As a result, 46,000 CCC courses are transferable to UC
  - 778 UC majors articulated

## Success: Strong Academic Performance

- Graduation rate, 4 years 82%
- Time to degree 2.4 years
- GPA at graduation 3.18
- Graduates' starting salaries on par with entering freshmen

### Transfer students graduate with degrees in workforce-critical majors.
