

UC Health Fiscal Year 2022-23 Report on Covered Affiliations

Annual Report on Affiliations with Health Care Organizations that have
Policy-Based Restrictions on Care

August 31, 2023

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OVERVIEW

In July 2021, the University of California Board of Regents approved [Regents Policy 4405: Policy on Affiliations with Healthcare Organizations that Have Adopted Policy-Based Restriction on Care](#). This policy governs affiliations between healthcare organizations that have policy-based restrictions on care and the University, including the University of California Health's academic health centers (AHCs) and health professional schools. The Regents Policy and coupled with the [Interim Policy: Affiliations with Certain Healthcare Organizations](#), released in September 2021, are intended to protect the ability of UC clinicians and trainees working at those organizations ("covered affiliates") to provide evidence-based, appropriate care to all patients. The final draft of the President's Policy will undergo systemwide review through October 13, 2023, and is planned for finalization and publication in December 2023.

To promote complete and consistent adoption of the policies across the system, UC Health convenes various working groups comprised of representatives from each UC Health location. These groups work closely with local teams to apply the policy guidelines and contribute to the annual UC Health report on these affiliations. The first annual report on covered affiliates was presented to the UC Regents' Health Services Committee in August 2022, and updates will be provided annually.

The following annual report for Fiscal Year 2022-23 (FY22-23) provides an update on the development and implementation of consistent procedures, due diligence, reporting, model communications, and establishment of governance as required by the policies.

IMPLEMENTATION UPDATE JULY 1, 2022 – JUNE 30, 2023

The following outlines the status of implementation efforts for FY22-23. An overview of all requirements and implementation status is also available in [Appendix A](#).

1. Interim Policy Review

The Interim Presidential Policy on Affiliations with Certain Healthcare Organizations was released in September 2021 to support implementation of Regents' Policy 4405. During this time, the interim policy has undergone significant review with stakeholders across the UC system including a full 90-day academic review, discussions with the newly established Joint Clinical Advisory Committee on Covered Affiliations, feedback from UC Regents meetings, and review with internal and external counsel. A final draft of the policy was submitted to the UC Policy Advisory Committee for an additional systemwide review through October 12, 2023 and is planned for finalization and publication later this year.

2. Moratorium on New Non-Compliant Agreements

Effective July 1, 2021, the University implemented a moratorium on all new agreements with covered affiliates that were not in compliance with the Regents Policy.

3. Affiliation Agreement Due Diligence

The interim presidential policy includes a due diligence checklist that must be completed before entering into an agreement with a covered affiliate and requires new approval processes to ensure all new and renewed contracts with covered affiliates align with the Regents policy. All UC Health locations have implemented these requirements.

4. Contract Amendments

The interim policy provides non-discrimination contracting language that is being included in new and existing contracts at all UC Health locations. This language clearly outlines the expectations of the University that when UC providers are working or training at a covered affiliate site, they are expected to:

- make clinical decisions consistent with the standard of care and their independent professional judgment, respecting each individual patient's needs and wishes;
- inform patients of all health care options, regardless of whether those options are available through the covered affiliate, prescribe any interventions that are medically necessary and appropriate, and transfer or refer patients to other facilities when it is in the patient's interest; and,
- provide any item or service deemed necessary and appropriate in the event of an emergency, without restriction, and without seeking approval from any non-licensed health care provider.

All agreements with covered affiliates must comply with the Regents' and interim systemwide policies or be terminated by December 31, 2023. To support this effort, UC Legal negotiated omnibus agreements that have compliant, non-discrimination language with all major private/non-profit health systems with identified policy-based restrictions on care, including Dignity/CommonSpirit Health, Adventist Health, and Providence Health systems.

5. Total Impacted Agreements

As a result of implementing the affiliation policies, UC Health locations identified approximately **215 total impacted agreements with private/non-profit covered affiliates**. In total as of August 31, 2023:

- 140 agreements have been amended/negotiated with policy-compliant language;
- 46 agreements have/will be ended by December 31st:
 - 3 training agreements were terminated by UCI with Loma Linda (2) and Providence Health (1) and trainees were not assigned there in FY22-23;
 - 1 agreement with UC Davis Health and Dignity Health was terminated for business purposes, and replaced by a new, compliant agreement;
 - 34 agreements were not renewed upon expiration; and,
 - 8 agreements will end on/before December 31st.
- 8 agreements expired and are currently under renegotiation, all of which fall under omnibus agreements; and
- 21 agreements have negotiations in progress/pending to be brought into compliance, of which, ***only 3 agreements in progress/pending are not covered under current omnibus agreements.***

UC legal and contracting teams at each health location are actively engaged in bringing all remaining agreements into compliance with policy by December 31, 2023, or they will be terminated.

6. Communications

Model language and guidance were developed for use by the AHCs and health professional schools. The aims of these communications were to:

- Raise awareness of the policy-based restrictions on care at partner organizations;
- Educate on patients' options for care, and details for faculty, staff and trainees including their protections under the policy;
- Provide specifics for faculty, staff, and trainees concerning their rights; and,
- Provide a process for submitting a complaint/grievance, and who to contact for assistance.

The standardized language provided to the AHCs has been added to their patient web pages and incorporated into their patient transfer processes. See [Appendix B](#) for the list of UC Health location patient communications websites.

Separate communications designed for faculty, staff and trainees have been distributed to each health campus for local distribution and incorporation into ongoing communication and training processes. The messages provide an overview of the policy and expressly conveys the University's expectation that UC personnel and trainees make clinical decisions consistent with the standard of care and their independent professional judgment.

Once the interim systemwide policy is finalized, additional communications will be provided to align with any finalized guidance as needed.

7. Complaint Resolution

Each UC Health location identified complaint resolution contacts listed in [Appendix C](#) and developed processes for receiving, evaluating, and resolving complaints or grievances from patients, trainees, and personnel related to care received or provided at covered affiliates as follows:

- a. Reviewed channels and processes for receiving complaints or grievances from UC Health patients, trainees, faculty, and staff related to care received or provided at covered affiliate facilities, identified contacts responsible for evaluating and reporting on complaints, and identified a point of contact at UC Health locations to whom UC personnel and trainees can reach out to for assistance if they believe their contractual rights are being impeded.
- b. If received, concerns raised about impediments to accessing reproductive health care, gender affirming services, or end-of-life care will be escalated promptly to the Chief Executive Officer or designee.

8. Annual Reporting

The policies require an annual report on covered affiliations be delivered to the Regents. Building upon last year's reporting model, committees and working groups throughout UC health locations implemented processes to capture required data from UC locations utilizing standard report templates. UC Health staff at UCOP provided technical support for coordination and data analysis.

FY22-23 reports include the following:

- **Affiliation Agreements** – Located in [Appendix D](#), each UC Health location continues to utilize systems to identify and consistently report on new, renewed, expired, or terminated affiliation agreements. Each location confirmed it is reviewing, monitoring, and tracking affiliations with covered organizations.

- **Complaints Report:** Each UC health location identified complaint reporting contacts and processes to receive and evaluate complaints or grievances.

As of June 30, 2023, the systems have been tested and concerns were routed through the identified contacts, but when adjudicated, no complaints were identified from patients, faculty, and students regarding their ability to provide or receive care under a covered agreement.

- **Quality Indicators Report:** UC Health locations developed a framework to monitor the quality of care provided at covered affiliates and report on standardized quality indicators. This framework includes the UC Health Covered Affiliations Quality Metrics Scorecard to measure publicly available data and assessment of complaints and grievances. The FY22-23 report includes the finalized scorecard with definitions in [Appendix E](#), followed by the Quality Indicators Report in [Appendix F](#).
- **Non-Compliant Agreements:** Per policy, locations have through December 31, 2023 to amend contracts or terminate non-compliant agreements.

9. Patient Transfer Process

A working group on patient transfers developed procedures to support the transfer of UC patients who require access to a restricted service from a covered affiliate's facility to a UC Health or other location where the service can be provided. UC Health locations are amending new and existing agreements with covered affiliates to outline expectations regarding these transfers. They also developed communications for UC personnel and trainees to be informed of the transfer process, and to inform patients about restrictions on care and alternative options at UC Health or other facilities.

10. Quality Metrics

A framework has been devised to monitor and report the quality of care provided at affiliate sites consistent with the Regents' and systemwide policies as listed in [Appendix E](#). During FY21-22, UC Health defined quality standards for hospitals that align with the quality domains of the Institute of Medicine¹, key elements of the reporting scorecard used by UC Health locations, and requirements of affiliation policies. In FY22-23, the UC Health Covered Affiliations Quality Metrics Scorecard was finalized, and locations participated in quality metrics reporting on performance. All data sourced for quality metrics reporting is publicly available through the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services and the California Department of Healthcare Access and Information (HCAI).

In addition, a dedicated quality metrics subgroup, which includes health quality and sexual and reproductive health professionals at UC Health locations, is evaluating methodology to report on

access to restricted services. This working group analyzed publicly available data sources and was not able to identify publicly available data that are appropriate measures of women's reproductive healthcare quality relevant to the policy. UC Health is continuing to work with these individuals and partnering with California Department of Healthcare Access and Information to identify alternative solutions. Reporting on reproductive and sexual health continues to be challenging due to limited publicly available data in California, balanced with a continued need to further protect the data of patients given the current and evolving climate on access to legal and safe abortions, particularly for those from care-limiting states.

11. Joint Clinical Advisory Committee on Covered Affiliations

The Executive Vice President for UC Health and the Chair of the Academic Senate co-chair the Joint Clinical Advisory Committee on Covered Affiliations to review reports on affiliations, solicit feedback from stakeholders, and provide input on UC Health policies on covered affiliations.

Per policy, members of the committee include:

- the Executive Vice President for UC Health or designee;
- the Academic Senate Chair or designee;
- the Chief Medical Officer of each UC academic health system or designee;
- an Academic Senate appointee who is an active (at least 0.5 FTE) clinician from each campus with an academic health system; and
- three additional members selected by the President not representing either UC Health or the Academic Senate.

The committee launched in June 2022 and is engaged and meeting to advise and provide input on policy and annual reporting on UC Health covered affiliations.

12. Audit of Affiliations by Ethics, Compliance, and Audit Services (ECAS)











































The policies require that ECAS conducts an audit of an appropriate sample of contracts with covered affiliates to ensure their adherence to the contracting guidelines after the December 2023 deadline. ECAS also conducted an interim review of policy implementation to advise UC Health and the Regents on any areas for improvement. ECAS will provide these results separately and UC Health will work to incorporate the best-practice recommendations prior to policy implementation being finalized December 31, 2023.

D: UC Health Report on Covered Affiliations July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023

The following is the second annual UC Health Report on Covered Affiliations, which includes data on covered health affiliations from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

Section I includes a summary of data on covered affiliations and Section II provides details on each new, renewed, expired, or terminated agreement with non-public organizations covered under the affiliations policies. Note, this report excludes public entities, such as Veteran’s Affairs and Indian Health Services.

I. SUMMARY OF COVERED AFFILIATIONS

The University of California implemented a moratorium on new non-compliant health agreements with covered affiliates on July 1, 2021. All UC Health locations are now utilizing policy-compliant language in new and renewed agreements and will continue to amend all existing contracts through December 31, 2023.

As a result of implementing the affiliation policies, UC Health locations identified approximately **215 total impacted agreements with private/non-profit covered affiliates**. In total:

- 140 agreements have been amended/negotiated with policy-compliant language;
- 46 agreements have/will be ended by December 31st:
 - 3 training agreements were terminated by UCI with Loma Linda (2) and Providence Health (1) and trainees were not assigned there in FY22-23;

FY22-23 Summary of Agreement Actions

The following tables provide summary data on updates to agreements with covered affiliations with private healthcare organizations from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Detailed information can be found in **Section II**.

Outlined in **Figure 1**, in FY22-23 UC Health locations entered into **28 new/expanded policy-compliant agreements and renewed/amended 56 existing agreements with policy-compliant language**. They also allowed **23 agreements to expire**, 5 of which were under negotiation at the time of this report, and 17 of which the department did not seek to renew. **Four agreements** were terminated, one of which was replaced with a new policy-compliant agreement.
