BUILDING THE NATIONAL MODEL: PRESIDENT'S TASK FORCE ON PREVENTING AND RESPONDING TO SEXUAL VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT

On June 20, 2014, President Napolitano announced the formation of a systemwide Task Force to oversee the University's wide-ranging efforts aimed at preventing and responding to sexual violence on UC campuses. In convening the Task Force, President Napolitano noted the current comprehensive programs on UC campuses that respond to, and prevent, sexual violence and sexual assault. The President charged the Task Force with developing a model that ensures the University of California will be the national leader in preventing and combating sexual violence and sexual assault.

The Task Force is comprised of three members of the UC Board of Regents (Regent Reiss, Regent Leong Clancy, and Regent Saifuddin) and a broad cross-section of representatives from survivors, campus police, survivor advocacy groups, campus Title IX officers, student conduct officers, faculty, systemwide and campus administrators, and two undergraduate and one graduate student. (Membership list attached.) In addition, five work groups that include members from all campuses across five functional areas supported the work of the Task Force. The President's Task Force on Preventing and Responding to Sexual Violence and Sexual Assault began its work on Phase I in July. This phase aimed at developing overarching recommendations for the UC Model. Throughout the summer, the Task Force with its five work groups met, reviewed relevant research, discussed best practices, and developed its recommendations on response and prevention of sexual violence and assault. Over 100 people were involved in Phase I.

The Task Force's recommendations to President Napolitano for Phase I are included in the *Initial Report to the President – Building the National Model: President's Task Force on Preventing and Responding to Sexual Violence and Sexual Assault*. Phase II begins immediately and will provide detailed steps for implementation. In addition, the Task Force and work groups will identify improvements on policy language, provide ongoing support for overall awareness efforts, and respond as needed to any state or federal proposed legislative changes.
